Dining for Life: Eat, Drink & Make a Difference!
Monday, Sept. 15 and Tuesday, Sept. 16

AUSTIN – This September, Austin restaurants are whipping up great food for an even greater cause. **Dining for Life**, presented by Trudy's, is Monday, September 15 and Tuesday, September 16, at select restaurants and eateries all across Austin.

Voted Austin's Best Food Event in 2010 by the Austin Chronicle Best of Awards, Dining for Life has raised over half a million dollars for Central Texans affected by HIV and AIDS over the past 22 years. Partaking in the event is simple: **You eat at a participating restaurant, and 10% to 50% of your tab will directly fund HIV prevention, outreach and care services right here in Austin.**

According to Dining for Life founder Dorsey Barger, "Eating out during Dining for Life is like throwing a dinner party, but without the cost, cooking or cleanup. And the money goes to life-saving services for people right here in Austin." You can view a sortable list of participating restaurants at www.diningforlife.org.

Over 6,000 people in the Austin-area have HIV; more than 15% of them don't know it. AIDS Services of Austin provides condoms, testing and education to over 10,000 Central Texans every year. ASA also serves over 1,600 people living with HIV and AIDS annually through case management, the Jack Sansing Dental Clinic, legal advocacy, the Helping Hands Food Bank and emergency financial assistance.
